

BREAD LOAF SCHOLARSHIPS

for Academy for Teachers Fellows

Scholarships: The Academy for Teachers is modeled on the Middlebury Bread Loaf School of English, where passionate students, most of them teachers, take inspiring classes in a beautiful mountain setting. Scholarships of \$5000, offered jointly by The Academy and Bread Loaf, will be awarded to Fellows of The Academy for Teachers who show a passion for literature, a love of creativity, and a devotion to teaching. We hope that six weeks among kindred spirits at Bread Loaf's Vermont campus – reading, discussing, writing, playing – will send them into the next school year rejuvenated.

Recipients may additionally apply for financial aid and special funding that can supplement the Academy/Bread Loaf scholarships up to the full cost of attendance.

Eligibility: Applicants must be Academy for Teachers Fellows and full-time teachers, of any subject, in a New York City metro-area school. Scholars need not pursue a Bread Loaf degree. Preference will be given to applicants who have not previously attended Bread Loaf.

Application Requirements:

- A resume.
- A writing sample of no more than 750 words (any sort of writing is acceptable academic, fiction, non-fiction, poetry, journalism, etc.)
- In one sentence, explain why you want to spend the summer at Bread Loaf. Then, expand on your reasons in 750 words or less.
- In addition, a letter of recommendation should be emailed by your recommender directly to the Academy for Teachers.
- Apply directly with the Academy for Teachers by January 8, 2025.

Award notifications: Winners will be announced by January 22, 2025. Note that selected scholars will need to provide official college transcripts to and if they wish, apply for financial aid through the Bread Loaf School of English; application materials for selected scholars will also be shared with the School.
